MSc Health Psychology

What is this course?

A 1 year course including placement designed to give you an understanding of all main areas of Health Psychology.

Who is it designed for?

Those wishing to work in the field of Health psychology or go on to become fully qualified Health Psychologists. Gain hands-on experience of methods for conducting research in diverse settings.

What will it enable me to do?

Work within a health-related post or continue your studies with a PhD, Stage 2 professional doctorate, further clinical psychology training or work as a research assistant.

MSc Applied Clinical Psychology

What is this course?

A 1 year course focused on the fundamentals of clinical and health psychology and practice. There is a strong focus on research, and professional development.

Who is it designed for?

This course is designed for those interested in psychological healthcare research, research design, governance and ethical considerations. It will give students research skills to be applied to healthcare settings and a foundation knowledge of clinical psychology approaches theories and practices.

What will it enable me to do?

Work in the area of psychology research or further study to become accredited psychologist.

MSc Applied Forensic Psychology with Counselling

What is this course?

A 2 year course including compulsory placement, with focus on counselling.

Who is it designed for?

This course is for graduates in psychology, who are interested in progressing to careers in the forensic services as practitioners, researchers or managers. It is also for those currently working in the criminal justice or forensic mental health systems, wishing to learn more about the theory and practice behind forensic psychology.

What will it enable me to do?

This course is accredited by the [British Psychological Society \(BPS\)](https://www.bps.org.uk/) and is the first step to becoming a forensic psychologist.

MSc Applied Psychology and Economic Behaviour

What is this course?

A 1 year course looking at psychology and economics to explore and understand the decisions people make.

Who is it designed for?

Those seeking to work in any area where understanding human decision-making is critical. Students on this course will have some understanding of economics or modelling.

What will it enable me to do?

A range of skills where an understanding of human behaviour is required. For example, government, banking, finance, healthcare, HR or management.
